

Hebrews 6: 18...THE OATH

God took an oath so we would have good reason not to give up.

This refers to an older piece of writing in Genesis 22 where God says to a guy named Abraham. . .

"I am taking an oath in my own name. I will bless you because of what you have done," announces the Lord. "You have not held back your son, your only son. "So I will certainly bless you. I will make your children after you as many as the stars in the sky. I will make them as many as the grains of sand on the seashore. Your children will take over the cities of their enemies. 18 All nations on earth will be blessed because of your children. All of that will happen because you have obeyed me."

There is a story here! Gen 22

Hebrews 6: 18...THE OATH

What is the difference between a promise and an oath?

The internet definition of a promise

prom·ise/ˈpräməs/ Noun:

A declaration or assurance that one will do a particular thing or that guarantees that a particular thing will happen.

Verb: Assure someone that one will definitely do, give, or arrange something; undertake or declare that something will happen.

Synonyms:

noun. pledge - undertaking - vow - word -engagement - hopeverb. pledge - vow - give one's word

Noun:

A solemn promise, often invoking a divine witness, regarding one's future action or behavior.

A sworn declaration that one will tell the truth, esp. in a court of law.





Who was Melchizedek....

A similar system of government seems to have prevailed in pre-Israelite (Canaanite) Jerusalem, where the king also carried the title of high priest. The Bible tells us that after Abraham (and his retainers) defeated a coalition of four kings from the east, Abraham was blessed by **Melchizedek**, king of Salem (Jerusalem). **Melchizedek** was also designated a priest: "And King **Melchizedek** of Salem brought out bread and wine; he was a priest of God Most High (*El Elyon*). He blessed him [Abraham], saying, 'Blessed be Abram of God Most High, / Creator of heaven and earth'
