We need to decide if we could help out there.

- Then, there is a need for 88 notebooks of 130 pages and 15 nail clippers for the mission disaster recover bags we are putting together. We need this for this week! Again, lets remember this need.
- We have started a support service for people in need where people get helped with gas. This is progressing and we need to update the fund next week.

'I AM has sent me to you.' "


## **Beginning - Man**

Genesis 2:7


the LORD God formed the man [ADAM]

## **Human Composition**

Around 99% of the human body is made up of the main elements of oxygen, carbon, hydrogen, nitrogen, calcium, and phosphorus.



**Oxygen (65%) Carbon (18%)** Hydrogen (10%) Nitrogen (3%) **Calcium (1.5%)** Phosphorus (1.0%) **Potassium (0.35%) Sulfur (0.25%) Sodium (0.15%)** magnesium (0.05%) Copper, Zinc, Selenium, Molybdenum, Fluorine, Chlorine, lodine, Manganese, Cobalt,



There are also trace amounts of Lithium, Strontium, Aluminum, Silicon, Lead, Vanadium, Arsenic and Bromine

Iron (0.70%)

They will have the right to come to the tree of life.


They will be allowed to go through the gates into the city.
