Epiphany!

Any idea of What this Word Means?

KOINE GREEK:

ἐπιφάνεια, epiphaneia, "manifestation", "striking

appearance"

IN CLASSICAL GREEK IT WAS USED OF THE APPEARANCE OF DAWN, OF AN ENEMY IN WAR, OR OF A MANIFESTATION OF A GOD.

- A revelatory manifestation of a divine being
- A sudden manifestation of the essence or meaning of something
- A comprehension or perception of reality by means of a sudden intuitive realization

Epiphany is the name of a **Holiday** (Holy Day) is a **Christian feast day** that celebrates the **revelation of God the Son as a human being** in **Jesus Christ**

Western Christians commemorate principally (but not solely) the visitation of the Biblical Magi to the Baby Jesus, and thus Jesus' physical manifestation to the Gentiles

Western Churches celebrate it on the 6th January

Eastern Christians commemorate the baptism of Jesus in the Jordan River, seen as his manifestation to the world as the Son of God.

Eastern Churches celebrate it on the 19th January

Matthew 2

The Magi Visit the Messiah

After Jesus was born in Bethlehem in Judea, during the time of King Herod, Magi from the east came to Jerusalem and asked,

"Where is the one who has been born king of the Jews? We saw his star when it rose and have come to worship him."

When King Herod heard this he was disturbed, and all Jerusalem with him. When he had called together all the people's chief priests and teachers of the law, he asked them where the Messiah was to be born.

Matthew 2

"In Bethlehem in Judea," they replied, "for this is what the prophet has written:

"But you, Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, are by no means least among the rulers of Judah; for out of you will come a ruler who will shepherd my people Israel.

Smart Magi. . .

After they had heard the king, they went on their way, and the star they had seen when it rose went ahead of them until it stopped over the place where the child was.

When they saw the star, they were overjoyed. On coming to the house, they saw the child with his mother Mary, and they bowed down and worshiped him. Then they opened their treasures and presented him with gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh.

And having been warned in a dream not to go back to Herod, they returned to their country by another route.

- 1. How many times does it refer to the Kings of the East bringing Jesus gifts? "O" ie Zero, None, Not one!
- 2. Who brought Jesus gifts? "Magi"
- 3. What does Magi mean?

Comes from **OLD PERSIAN word maguš, and** is a term, used since at least the 4th century BC, to denote **followers of Zoroaster** the **ability to read the stars**, and **manipulate the fate that the stars foretold**. The plural **"magi"** entered the English language around 1200. early church fathers, such as **St. Justin, Origen, St. Augustine and St. Jerome**, did not make an exception for the Gospel, and translated the word in its ordinary sense, i.e. as **"magician"**

4. Who are Magi?

"Zoroaster" – or rather what the Greeks supposed him to be – was for the Hellenists the figurehead of the 'magi, and the founder of that order. They dealt with astronomical speculations and magical lore.

Within the scheme of Greek thinking (which was always on the lookout for hidden significances and "real" meanings of words) his name was identified at first with star-worshiping (astrothytes "star sacrificer") and, with the Zo-, even as the living star

Magi was a term originally reserved for a particular tribe of Medes that were Priests of the Persian empire.

They were the ancient "Consultants" asked to represent the royal families. The chief of their order was in charge of the magic of the empire.

They watched stars to determine the significance of events.

It has been proposed that Daniel was in charge of the Magi at one time.

4. Who are Magi?

DANIEL

- King Nebuchadnezza of Babylon made Daniel "The Man!"
- Daniel 2:48

Then the king placed Daniel in a high position and lavished many gifts on him. He made him **ruler** over the entire province of Babylon and placed him **in charge of all its wise men**.

King Belshazzar continued honoring Daniel

Daniel 5:29

Then at Belshazzar's command, Daniel was clothed in purple, a gold chain was placed around his neck, and he was proclaimed the third highest ruler in the kingdom.

King Darius and King Cyrius of Persia continued the same way
 Daniel 6:28

So Daniel prospered during the reign of Darius and the reign of Cyrus[b] the Persian.

It is highly likely Daniel was a member or even leader of the Magi hundreds of years before Jesus was born!

They WERE ANCIENT KING's consultants and advisors!



1. How many magi brought Jesus gifts?

It doesn't say!

HOWEVER....

Those were time of thieves and robbers along the roads, so wealthy people travelled in big groups with private armed guards supporting them.

Possible for these types of gifts around 100 to 200 people would have been needed.

Then the bible says. . .


Why was it secretly... a king could demand couldn't he...was he perhaps a bit worried because of the number of armed supporters with the Magi and their political/military power?

"But you, Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, are by no means least among the rulers of Judah; for out of you will come a ruler who will shepherd my people Israel.

Micah 5:2 (NIV)

"But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah,
though you are small among the clans of Judah,
out of you will come for me
one who will be ruler over Israel,
whose origins are from of old,
from ancient times."

Do we believe the ancient writings saying that Jesus is God?

Are we willing to use our time and resources, minds and will to find the Son of God in our lifetime?
