# Day of preparation

Commemorates to the day the lamb was picked to die before the Passover that protected Israel's future, their first born sons!

Commemorates the day Jesus was picked as the lamb of God to die and protect our future, and he, JESUS, is the first born of all who died to re-enter heaven!

# What is the purpose of the day of Preparation

- Pick an pure innocent lamb?
- What are the attributes of a lamb?
- What are the attributes of Jesus?
- What was to happen to the lamb?
- What was to happen to Jesus?
- What did they do with passover lambs?
- What does the last supper represent?

# Why did Jesus die?

- 1 Peter 1:19
  - Instead, you were bought by the priceless blood of Christ. He is a perfect lamb. He doesn't have any flaws at all.
- John 3:16
  - God loved the world so much that he gave his one and only Son. Anyone who believes in him will not die but will have eternal life.

# So where does it all end

- Revelation 5:9

- Here is the new song they sang. “You are worthy to take the scroll and break open its seals. You are worthy because you were put to death. With your blood you bought people for God. They come from every tribe, language, people and nation.

God's covenant is realized!!!! Through Jesus,  
By the power of Holy Spirit To buy a people for  
God, by paying for what we could not pay, in a  
way we could not have envisaged for a purpose  
we cannot image!
