


We looked at James history as a brother of Jesus and leader in the church




We considered the 12 tribes and 10 lost tribes



The humble on this earth have their faith and the reality of religion tried and exposed. They have full opportunity to grasp God's hand and get help...



James was written somewhere around 45 to 50 A.D.

In what way could this have had a bearing on what James was writing?

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“Abandon Ship”

These were the last known words of Robin Walbridge, who was Captain of the Bounty a replica of the HMS bounty. The Bounty was a reconstruction of the 1787 British Royal Navy sailing ship and it capsized off North Carolina U.S.A. during hurricane Sandy.

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Many of us want to abandon ship on a promise we have made.

Normally due to the **difficulty in keeping to the promise** when times get tough. Yet **God never promises us a life without difficulties**, only a heavenly reward when life ends.

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Christians must have integrity!

We are people who live for more than life and so should not be submerged into life troubles to the point of giving up on our promises.

Sometimes it is hard to keep swimming through the difficulties and doing what we say, *but we should rather be careful of promising something which we cannot deliver.*

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One of these trials we need to persevere under is keeping our word.



It can be difficult and even dangerous. Robin Walbridge died in that heaving ocean looking for his crew safety first so they had the greatest chance of survival. This may have been to courage, or guilt. With us either is often the driver, but for Walbridge perhaps it was guilt and making up for wrong decisions as he had directed the ship into the path of the hurricane. Whether he did this deliberately or not is difficult to know.

never will I forsake you.”


